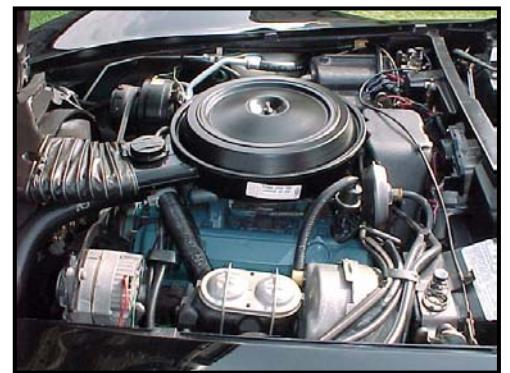
Pace Car, always thinking about the 1978 Corvette Pace Car I never got in 1980.
