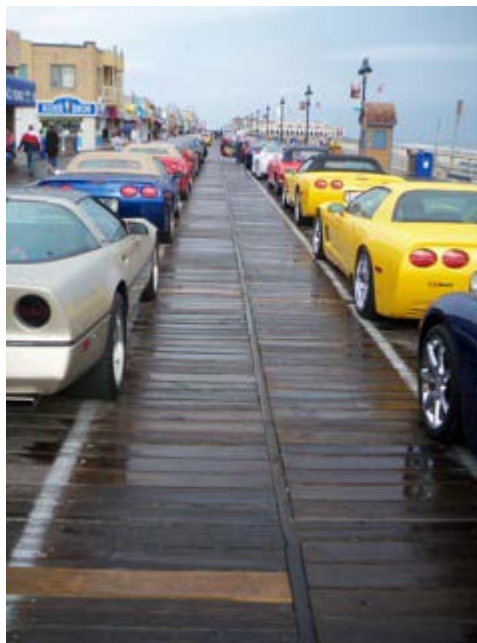
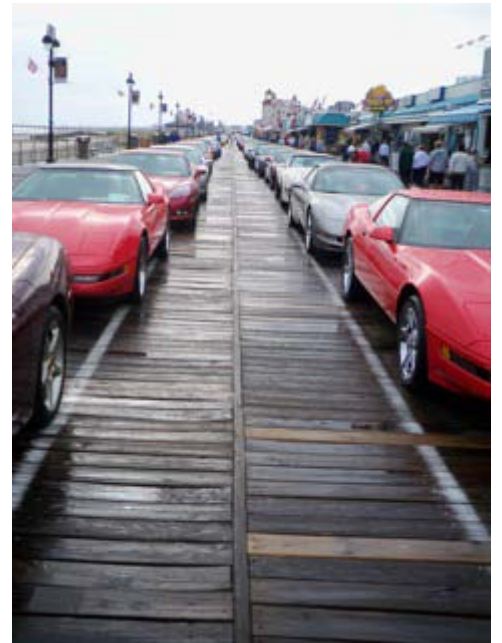

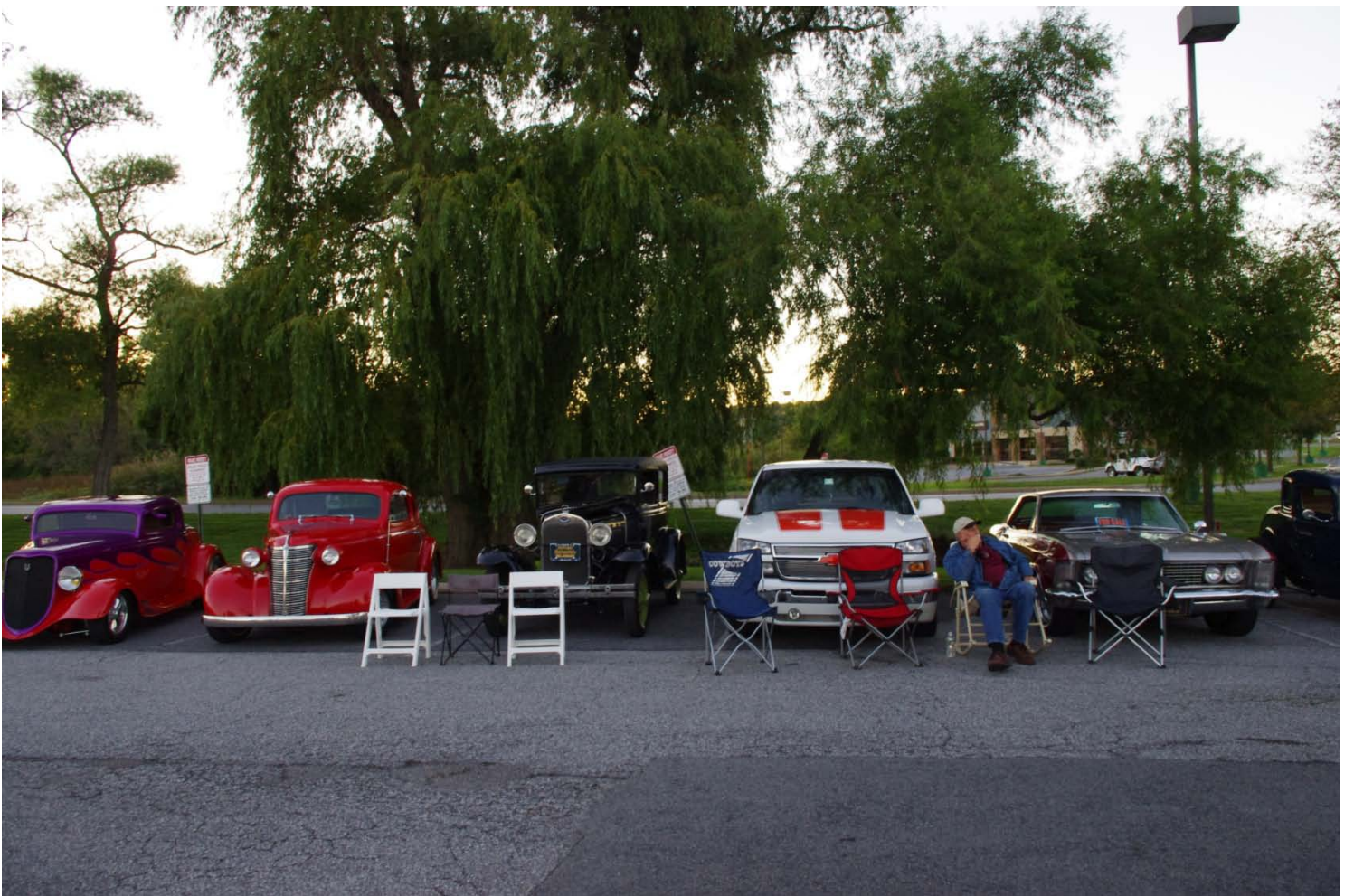
The awards were handed out 45 minutes early because more rain was on the way. It was announced that there were 450 Vettes in the show. Not a bad turn out.

This is one of the really fun days and we try to make it every year. Maybe you can make it next year??



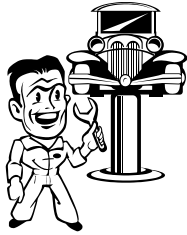
